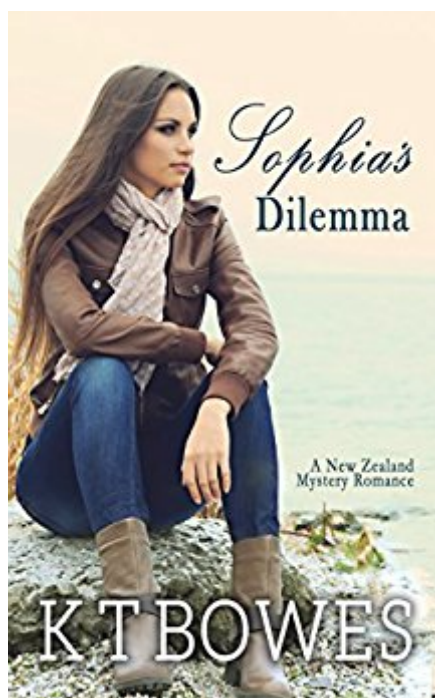

I enjoyed this novel, it

is well written and deals realistically with the issues surrounding teenagers today. I found it a really relaxing read, with some hard hitting points that made me think.
