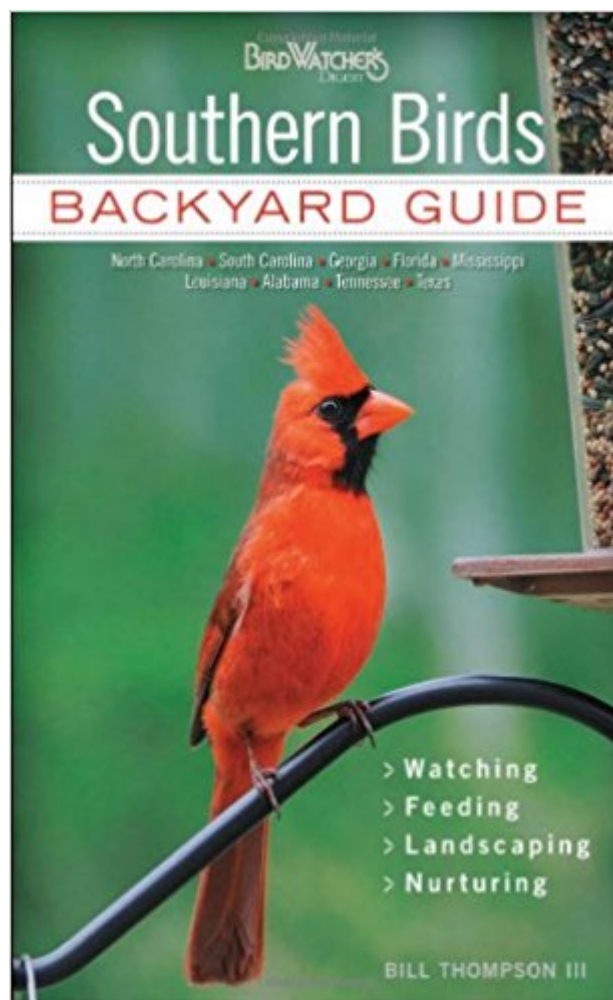

i was a little disappointed in this book...i was looking more for a bird identifier book...this is more of a guide on how to build a sanctuary for attracting birds....but it is a good one for that for sure...

I enjoy sitting on the front porch watching the birds that come to my feeder. I keep this book by the front door to look up new visitors. I really like the way this book is organized. Sometimes I know exactly what bird I'm looking at (a Cardinal, for example, is hard to mistake.) in that case I may skip directly to the how-to-attract-it section. My only real complaint is that the photos (deliberately) show the most distinctive and vivid examples of a species color and markings. I would prefer to see a more typical example. That's just my opinion.

This is mostly written. Only pictures of males and those pictures are of poor quality . I don't recommend this book.

I bought this book for my 95 year old mother who is in the top assistance level of a nursing home. One of her greatest pleasures is still watching the birds who come to the feeder outside her window. When I visited her recently and took her the book, we really enjoyed looking up the various birds that we saw in the feeder and for just a few moments, my Mom had some peace and joy and a brief journey back into the earlier parts of her life.
