

Made into a movie by the same name, The Hiding Place portrays her familyââ \neg â,¢s efforts to hide Jews during the German occupations of The Netherlands during World War II, and of how God sustained Corrie through the atrocities of a concentration camp after she and her family were captured by the Nazis. Upon her release and until her death in1983, Corrie traveled the world, preaching the gospel to the lost and encouraging the church with her message of love, faith, and forgiveness.

Although this is a book of meditations, it is a book of meditations that relates chapters before and after each other. Sometimes, Corrie even spends multiple chapters discussing a topic. Even though the meditations are labeled as devotions, it is all chronological since the book is based off Corrie Ten Boom's radio broadcasts. Corrie prays for others and praises the Lord at the end of each devotional. She may repeat a favorite piece of scripture a time or two, but it is best to be open minded, especially since they were her favorites and she was rising in years. May peace be with her in heaven.

These 40 devotionals from Corrie ten Boom's radio broadcasts from 1966 until the early 1970s have really impacted my spiritual walk, especially in the area of surrender/submission to God. Corrie shares transparently about her own struggle in this area and gives down-to-earth advice in her earnest, heartfelt way that exhorts her fellow believers to trust and surrender fully to the only One worthy this. Highly recommended!

I love reading Corrie Ten Boom's books. I believe that this one was taken from radio interviews that

she gave, so it's nice to be able to read about things that we in America may not have had a chance to get access to.
