

The book was more than I'd expected it to be and done very well, full color illustrations were excellent. However, I can only give it 4 stars, would have been 3.5 had that been possible since the section on acrylics was so limited as to the expansive and diverse capabilities of acrylics. Would recommend this book to anyone interested in developing their knowledge of drawing and painting horses as a starter and grow from there. If you're really into expanding your acrylic painting

capabilities, I'd suggest checking out David Kitler's, Reliable Results in Acrylics and then his Painting Natures Textures, for more in depth examples regarding techniques to of just what can be accomplished in creating stunning works of art in the animal world (both are DVD only). For another great book on Acrylics "Acrylics for Dummies" ... great color renderings and expert advice on techniques....nothing Dummy about it!

I am a graphic artist and watercolour and coloured pencil, usually you have to buy different books for each but this one covers everything including pastel and oil
