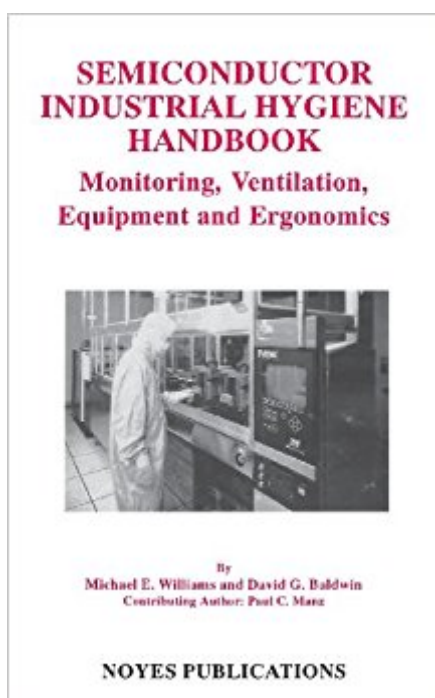


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Semiconductor Industrial Hygiene Handbook: Monitoring, Ventilation, Equipment And Ergonomics
