

The trail is so well marked that it would be nearly impossible to lose the way (even at night), but the guidebook is an indispensable resource for trailhead parking, water supplies and campsites. Everything you want to know about the trail is in this book. A word of caution - the SHT has been changing rapidly with new section openings and campsites. Make sure you have the most recent version or the section of trail you plan to hike may not be in your guidebook.

Just what I was looking for. I will use it when hiking portions of the trail this summer (2017).

We hiked 60 miles of this trail in 4 days and would still be in the woods without this book. Its mile by mile description of the trail, landscape, features, water sources, and campsites is perfection next to most trail guides. This book will help you plan a backpacking trip or a day hike through the state parks. Easy to understand directions to parking lots and trail heads as well as to campsites and trail spurs.
