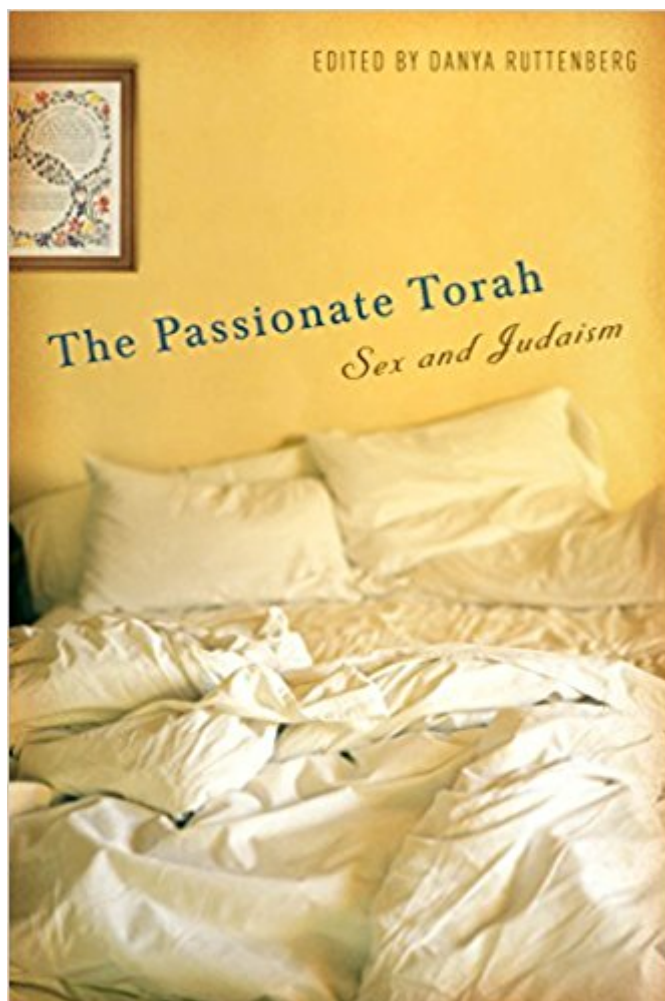

I wasn't a giant fan of Ruttenberg's biography so I was skeptical about this book. I was pleasantly surprised that I really enjoyed reading this book of essays. Since they are essays by many different people, there is some unevenness but generally the quality is very high with a lot of new thought about a very old subject. My favorite essay was the one by Jay Michaelson and as a result I bought his two recent books.

This book was approached by person who wanted to think about ethics and sexuality from a Jewish point of view. I am 58 and these are still questions I wonder about. By choosing to include a large series of essays, many issues are discussed from ritual purity, desire for children, status of women, homosexuality, androgyny, and birth control. The most important discovery of this book is that the many of the issues are discussed in an understanding way by such books of Jewish learnings as the Babylonian Talmud. Judaism has been struggling with these type of issues for its length of days. Most essays start with the tradition, but say with more knowledge we need to modify our understanding of the tradition and its values. There are, of course, the political tract pieces you are bound to find in this a series of essays that unsatisfyingly since they see things in with only one lense. But even here, there are things to learn and think about. This is good book to clearly bring up the issues and help us progress to an even better Jewish ethic on these issues, which help individuals cope in a good and holy way with the passions of life.
