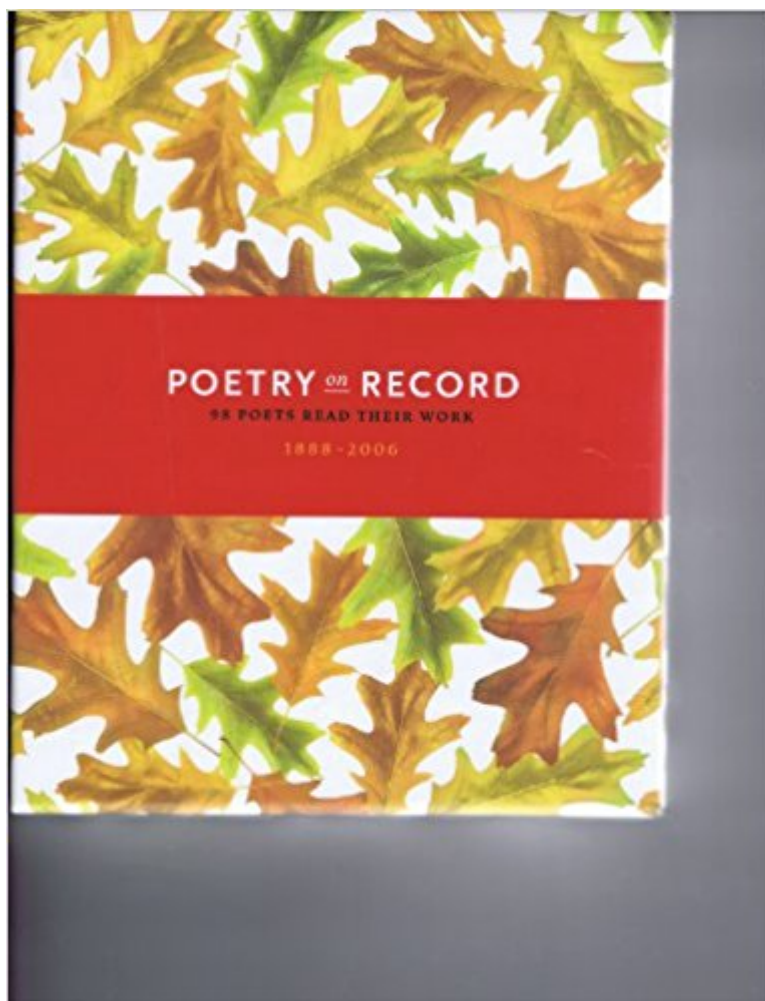

This collection, arranged chronologically by the poets' birth dates, regardless of continuity, style, or recording quality, and without narration, introduction, or internal identification of the poets or their titles, communicates in a kind of hodgepodge the range and fullness of modern poetry. Experienced in its entirety, it highlights most uniquely the way in which not just poetic style and recording technology have evolved, but voices and pronunciation themselves.
