

This was a great book to help the reader look deeper at common phrases used by Christians. I've heard many of these phrases spoken by family, friends and religious leaders. Though all had good intentions, to the receiving ears the words may be confusing or even harsh. This book challenges the reader to think about the deeper meaning of the phrases and suggests more appropriate words or actions.

Thought provoking and a good book for Christians to read. Rev. Hamilton calls the book "Half Truths" but he is too modest. He is right more often than he is wrong so I would have called it "75 Percent Truths". For example, we are to hate sin. Hate it for how it hurts people and for how it hurts God. We are also to love people we know are sinning. We are of no help to them if we simply ignore the sin or if we fail to love them. The book is a good discussion starter for small groups, rather than a set of final answers.

Good reference to have to remind people to think more carefully about their comments.

Mr. Hamilton gave me a completely new perspective on these statements I've heard many times; I particularly enjoyed the one "Everything happens for a reason"..the reason being I made some very stupid decisions...
