

Walvoord is Chancellor of Dallas Theological Seminary, and was on the school's faculty for 50 years, including its president from 1952-1986. He has written numerous books, most of which, like Rapture Question and The Millennial Kingdom,

relate to Bible prophecy. He is also the coeditor of the best-selling Bible Knowledge Commentary.
