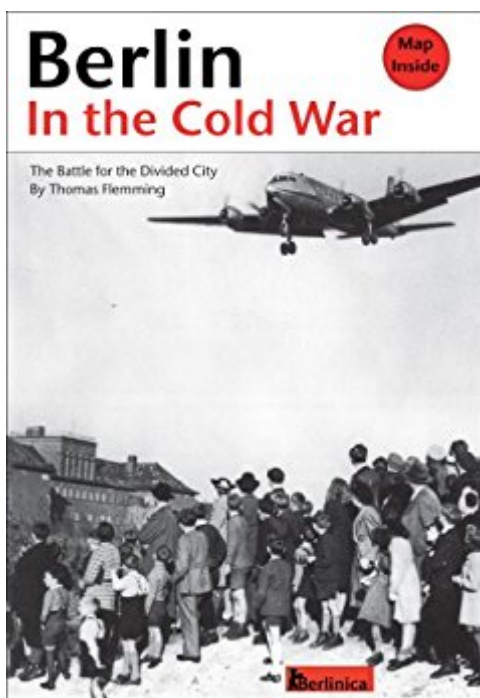

When people think of the Cold War, they usually picture the US vs. the Soviets. Berlin in the Cold War reminds us that the front line was centered in the divided city, where tensions ran high and the situation was often precarious. The book also reveals how much was sacrificed in Berlin, as the battle between the superpowers played out. Berlin in the Cold War isn't a long-winded didactic treatise on Cold War strategy or a zealous defense of any particular political view. It's a concise, accessible history of what Berlin endured as the front line in the Cold War, beginning in the wake of WWII, through the fall of the Berlin Wall.

This book is short, but not abbreviated. The story and pictures are fascinating, compelling, and saddening. In a small paperback, Flemming covers a surprising amount of detail without getting tiresome. There are also carefully phrased touches of irony that seemed to come along just when I was thinking "Now isn't that odd" about the events described. The Cuban missile crisis has tended to erase prior threats of WWII from our minds, but Flemming reminds us of other moments when the future balanced on a knife-edge.

A mass of detail, while maintaining readability. I purchased this book to refresh my view of the events that took place in the Cold War with reference to Berlin. This book effectively and intriguingly presented Berlin's history of the cold war. It is well organized, and I can assure you that any person who wishes to use this book to brush up on the matter will encounter not only accuracy but also a surprisingly pleasant read.
