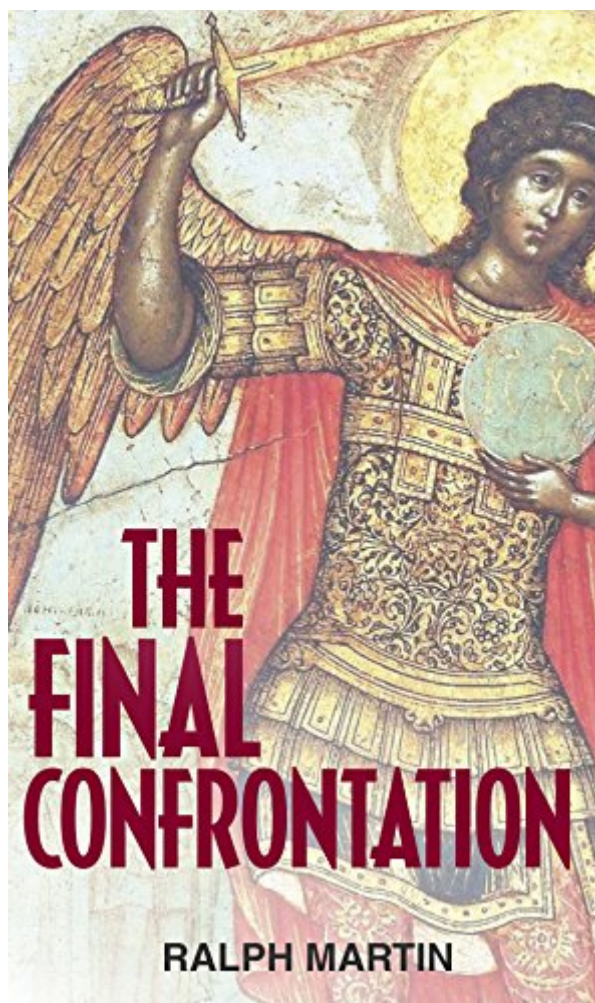

This short book/pamphlet gives the most authentic background and history of what probably has already started: the final confrontation.
