

"A hope-filled anthem for the woman who feels she is both too much and never enough. This book had me at its tagline. As a spiritual-but-not-exactly-Christian woman, I hesitated as to whether or not I should read it. In the end, I am so grateful to have followed the gentle nudging of my heart toward this book and its message. Let's be clear: this is a Christian book -- written by Christian women, for Christian women. And, while I have recently followed the gentle tug of my heart to explore the Christian faith, I don't know that I could honestly or accurately call myself a Christian. As a non-Christian, I read this book knowing that I am not the intended reader - and that my interpretation of its message may differ from that intended by the authors. In my fledging exploration of Christianity, I will admit that I found myself stumbling around some of the language used throughout this book. The authors define WILD as: walking in who God made us to be and FREE as: resting in what Jesus has done for us. I still struggle to fully understand or accept this definition of FREE. Even so, I cannot help but express that the message underlying this book is such a beautiful call: one of turning away from the limiting stories of the dominant culture, and instead surrendering our lives to the call that has been placed in our hearts: to share our gifts in service and as an expression of God. Jess and Haley share so openly their own struggles and wrestling with feeling both "too much" and "not enough," a theme I believe all

women in this culture can relate to. I found their heartfelt stories of struggle and surrender so comforting and encouraging. The book's tagline is not an empty declaration: this book is, in fact, a hope-filled anthem. If, like me, your heart tugs yearningly as you read this tagline, I urge you to open your heart and your mind to hear the underlying message within this book's pages. You may stumble, as I did, with the specifically Christian perspective of this book. Even so, it is worth the open-hearted wrestling the book will inspire in your heart and mind. I recognize the irony of reading a book in which the ultimate message is redemption in Christ, while conveniently "reading around" that particular part of the message. I hope the authors of this book will forgive this as I read their book through the lens of my own authentic (if imperfect) faith. "You are as holy as you are, as wild as you are, as free as you are, and as loved by God as you are." Please note: I received an advanced copy of this book in exchange for this honest and heartfelt review.

I just finished reading this book and loved every word. If anyone is in need of encouragement, this book is for you. Essentially, the book talks about how if we're saved by God, we are free in Christ and can live like it. We are not bound to others' expectations, and this brings us freedom in daily life, because of what Christ has done. This book is a surprisingly deep look at how we buy into the lies perpetuated by society that women cannot be wild and free, much less in Christ. We're either told we're too "out there" or else we're "not enough," neither of which is true. Connolly and Morgan encourage their readers to live free and unashamed in the knowledge that they are daughters of the True King, and offer real-life examples of what that might look like. They also share their own struggles and experiences. The result is a

really honest, encouraging read. 4/5 stars.
