I understand the idea behind the treasure hunt. I think the book is well written. I don't agree with using this formula or any formula. I think the testimonies in the book are wonderfully encouraging and the basic premise that we need to be bold, manifest the kingdom of God and show love to people are all wonderful. I do take issue with "make up a word of knowledge" They explained why they thought it was okay but that isn't what Jesus did or what we were instructed to do in the word. If you want to understand how to move in any gift I recommend reading The Gifts and Ministries of the Holy Spirit by Lester Sumrall. He was an evangelist who has since moved to heaven and that book is wonderful. It lays out how to believe God for the greater gifts, gives testimonies of them in current operation and gives examples from scripture through the whole bible for each gift. It will leave you with a thorough understanding of what God has been working in you already and a hunger for more of Him. It will also help you keep wrong ideas out like making up a word of knowledge...that seems like an invitation to b deceived by clairvoyant spirits. I think the best part about this book is the simple advice of encouraging us to step out. We shouldn't be spectators in the body asking Pastors to do all the work. There are lots of good things in the book...but be mindful that you are an individual and God may have you minister to people in a different way than this treasure hunt. I hope no one gets hung up on getting words of knowledge flowing or trying to be like someone else. God made you to be an amazing and unique part of the body of Christ and he has a way for you to minister to people that will be full of his peace. When you find it; the Grace of God will open doors and his favor will make your ministry path very clear. You may be used primarily in discerning of spirits or encouragement. Remember that "One plants and One waters" BUT Only God brings the increase...so don't let anyone make you feel less than if you are a seed planter. Without people planting seeds of love, encouragement and comfort the hearts of people wouldn't be prepared to even be touched in the way described in this book.

This book will get you excited about doing something that has never been appealing before (if you are like me). Witnessing to a complete stranger has always been something I shied away from. But, be advised, reading this book will get you wanting to jump in with both feet. Great testimonies of God's love in action!

I have daughters who have practiced this method of finding people who were desperate for God's encouragement, and wanted to know more about it. This book does a good job of explaining what exactly "Treasure Hunters" are (people who are seeking the people God wants to encourage/heal/bring into His Kingdom), what the "Treasure" is (the people God is seeking), and how the two get together. I recently went to a conference where this method was practiced, and it was a positive way to let people know just how much God loved them and was seeking them for their good. This book filled in many gaps where I just didn't "get it" in the short conference. I would recommend that others read this, contemplate what Dedmon is really saying about how to bring the grace of God to those Jesus misses most, and consider putting this into action. I now cannot go out without asking God what He wants to say to the people around me, and God often answers!

The anecdotal format makes for an easy read, but I also appreciated the teaching perspective the author incorporated into his book. Regardless if each reader finds this style of evangelism something they feel compelled to try, it will most certainly give each reader a heightened awareness of God's deep love for the lost. I have been challenged by this author to evaluate my own sense of urgency and compassion for the lost. Strongly recommend to all Christians who desire to have a mind and heart after God's.

This is a life-changing book. Kevin shows how the Holy Spirit will highlight people for you to impact with the Kingdom of God.
