

(The book is rated for older kids, so the content is probably appropriate for them.) This book attempts to demonstrate that God had/has a plan for our nation, and how He has worked providentially in our history. I have never read a book before that so purposefully tries to set forth history as His (God's) story - reminiscent of Diana Waring's cds. My first grader and I are enjoying it very much.
