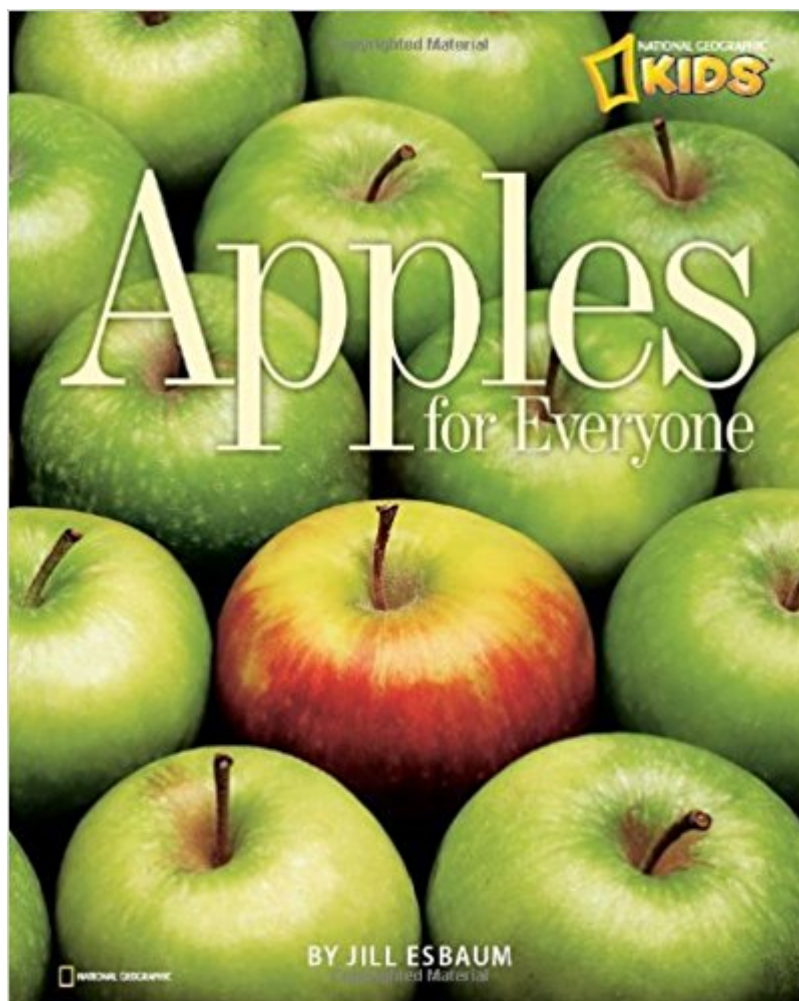

Though they have little to do with the science behind the planet's changing seasons, the

new titles in the Picture the Seasons series do a fabulous job of conjuring up the sights, smells, and sensations of a brisk autumn. Using minimal text with National Geographic's typically fine photographs, Esbaum brings out familiar, comforting details of the outdoors and slips in a lesson or two so skillfully readers won't even mind. Apples for Everyone starts small with extreme close-ups of buds and bees before wowing with wide shots of apple-strewn orchards and massive buckets of fruit. The writing flows with sensory details ("Your teeth sink in crunch! and tart-sweet juice dribbles down your chin") and works in bits of history, such as the story of Johnny Appleseed. Fun, cozy, evocative stuff Grades K-2. --Daniel Kraus

Jill Esbaum is the award-winning author of several books for young readers. She lives on a farm near Dixon, Iowa, with her husband and family. She loves visiting school, as well as teaching adults how to write for children in numerous classes and workshops.

This is a beautiful book that gives young readers information on how apples grow and other facts about the fruit. The book features a large, colorful font for easy reading and vibrant photographs that show an apple's development from bloom to harvest. It also depicts a variety of children enjoying apple goodness in various forms from caramel to cider. I would recommend this book along with another one of Esbaum's book, "Seed, Sprout, Pumpkin, Pie" for the splendid photography and the simply written information about some of the foods and activities many children enjoy every autumn season. I'm looking forward to reading both of these great books to my granddaughter and will also be adding "Everything Spring" and "Winter Wonderland" to her book collection.

I like this book because of the wonderful illustrations, how it shows apple production (from blossom to market), the pictures of children with apples, and the subtle humor in some of the text. I have used it in pre-K to 5th grade classes. All have enjoyed it. I like to bring in a variety of apples for students to see and handle after we read it. By doing so, they gain a better understanding of the descriptions and varieties they see in the book.

A wonderful book with gorgeous pictures and excellent text. It can be used in a Venn Diagram comparing Apples and Pumpkins by using the book "Seed, Sprout Pumpkin Pie," along with this

book. Or, just read it for the beauty of the book and the seasons.

Both my five year old and seven year old love these books and we bring them out as the seasons change to help illustrate what is going on in our own back yard. Your child will not even know he/she is learning!
