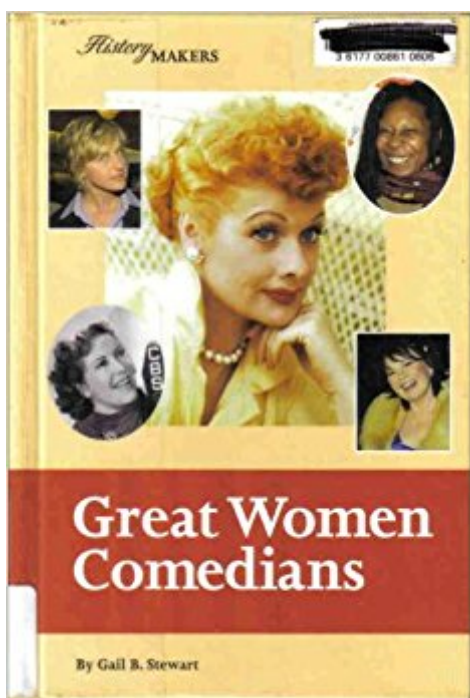

Grade 5-8-Brief but solid biographies of five groundbreaking comedians: Gracie Allen, Lucille Ball, Whoopi Goldberg, Roseanne, and Ellen DeGeneres. The introduction describes the traditional lack of acceptance of women in comedy, and mentions other examples of this kind of discrimination, such as that experienced by Edna St. Vincent Millay, who wrote humorous pieces under a pseudonym. The accounts focus on how the subjects broke down barriers and gained acceptance for themselves and for the women who would follow them. The book discusses not only the comedians' careers, but also their personal struggles. The black-and-white photos include some shots of the subjects as children. Quotes are footnoted and the sources are listed in the notes. The annotations for the works consulted indicate the best features of each title. Along with a list of books for further reading, this feature provides a helpful starting point for readers wanting to find out more about these talented performers.
