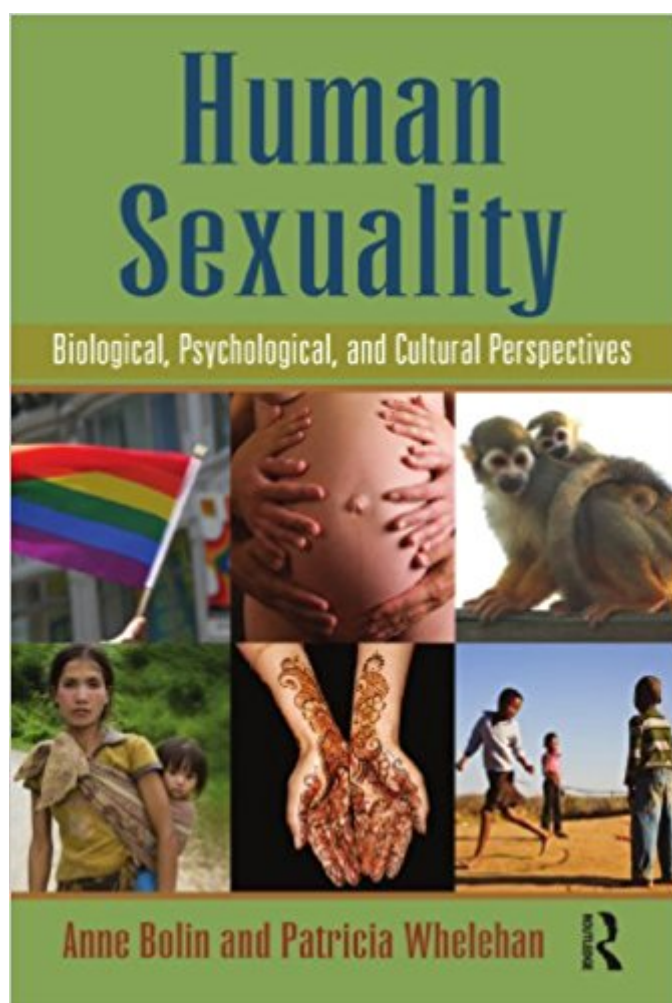

University and is the recipient of the Elon University Distinguished Scholar Award. She is the co-author of *Perspectives on Human Sexuality* (1999) with Patricia Whelehan. She is also co-author of *Athletic Intruders: Women, Culture and Exercise* (2003) with Jane Granskog. She is a Diplomate with the American Board of Sexology, a certified sex researcher, Fellow of the Society for Applied Anthropology, former co-chair/co-founder and currently Steering Committee member of the Human Sexuality and Anthropology Interest Group. Patricia Whelehan is Professor of Anthropology and AIDS Education Coordinator at SUNY-Potsdam.
