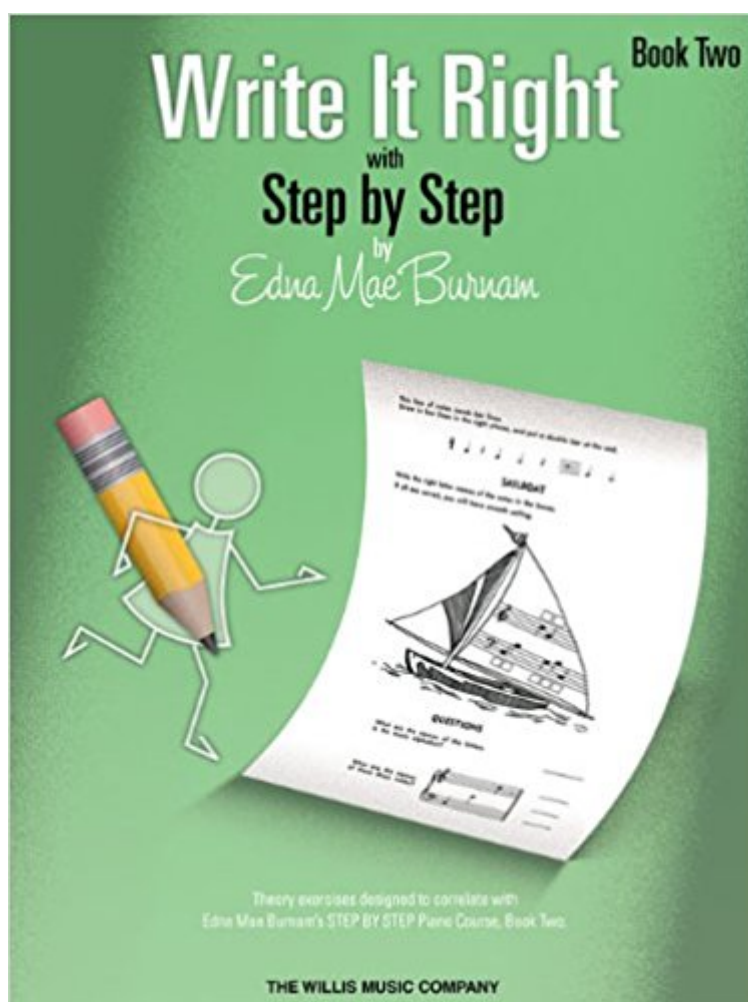

I love these books. I took 4 years of lessons as a child, but had not played in 50 years (I am 63). I tried several other Adult Beginner books, and gave up about 3/4 of the way through the first book. They just went too fast, and were too hard. This series goes very slowly so you can feel success. Because I had lessons as a child, I zipped through Books 1 and 2 in a few weeks. Book Three is getting harder. I order all three books at each level (Step by Step, Write it Right and Pieces to Play).

I've taught piano lessons for years using a different method. I have found that most kids struggle learning the notes. I started using this Step by Step method on my two youngest children, who had given up the piano because it was too hard, and they LOVE it. My son, who is 11, practices every

day now and says that piano is easy. I wish I had found this earlier!

Have used Edna Mae Burnhams books with many, many piano students with great success.

This is a very easy to understand learning tool for any beginner. My daughter did great with it and learned a lot from it.
