

I have not been compelled to write a review before but I am so disappointed with this book that I want to forewarn any potential buyer. I excitedly bought this book largely based on the other stellar 5-star reviews; and now, after reading this book I am quite skeptical about the legitimacy of those reviews. First of all, this book is so general and based on common sense - there is very little rigorous research, let alone novel advice or ideas, to be found in a book valued at \$39.95. And, what little worthwhile information is in this book, such as the different sources of business funding, can be found guite guickly on the internet. Among many low points of this book is a section titled "organize your research" which includes a bulleted list of things you should "never leave home without" including "a notepad and pen (or micro recorder), business cards, and expandable travel folder". This section goes on with shockingly common sense bulleted points such as "set up a business plan file cabinet, create hanging files and file folders, and empty your pockets and travel folder daily. By taking just a few minutes to review, sort, and file data gathered that day, you will be abled to make notes and comments that may be lost to you weeks from now". Furthermore, this book is full of advice that is embarrassingly redundant and low-level such as "Remember assumptions are not conclusions. When deciding what data you need to construct your business plan, don't make unnecessary assumptions. Assumptions, by definition, are personal beliefs not supported by fact. Assumptions are not a reliable foundation for decision-making and business success". Not surprising, there is no information to be found about the credentials of the author nor an "about the author" or similar section in this book. The lines per page and font size in this book is insulting to an intelligent audience, not to mention the double-spaced index with referenced items such as "customers", "events", "industry", "family", and "internet" - to name a few.
