

This is the third in a trilogy detailing the 101st Airborne action in the European theater. Hundreds of personal accounts are woven together to provide an excellent day-by-day (sometimes hour-by-hour) description of events during the last major German offensive of WWII in Dec 44-Jan 45, more commonly referred to as the Battle of the Bulge. The arrangement of chapters in chronological order with associated maps provided a clear picture of the events as they unfolded. This wasn't always the case in the author's previous book related to the Market Garden campaign in the fall of '44. Don't be fooled by the title into thinking this is focused solely on the 101st Airborne. Other armor, artillery, and aviation units that participated are represented in the story as well.

I grew up knowing one of the Battered Bastards of Bastogne, and I spent many evenings listening to him tell stories about these events. This book has given me more insight into the lives of the brave soldiers who served during the war. The book can be a little hard to follow, since it is basically takes the pieces of the actual soldier's stories and ties them together. But it is worth the time to understand what it was like to overcome the obstacles of ever day life during one of the most interesting the battles of WWII. It was definitely bravery above and beyond the call of duty.
