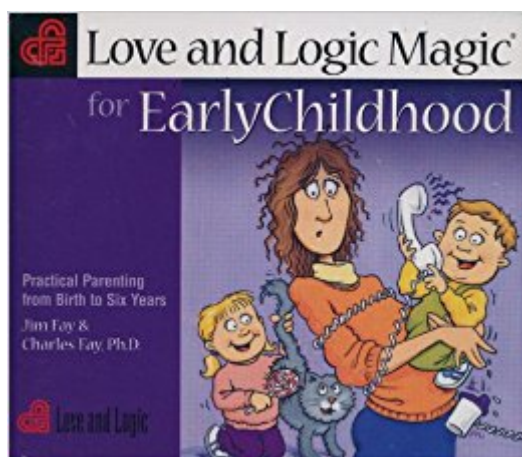

I thought this helpful book especially in the area of having empathy with my children so as to avoid them going into defensive mode. The only thing I would say negatively is many of the examples of how to deal with situations in public I do not think work very well if you have 4 kids under the age of 5. I can't imagine stopping in the store and acting out this whole logic and option scenario when three other kids going stir crazy

Our pediatrician has been recommending this book to us for two years, and I finally picked it up. I love the strategies and they are very easy to integrate. Our kids are learning about boundaries without us having to come down hard on them.

Good, practical advice, but not too helpful for children under the age of 3. Your child must be able to understand what you are saying and/or asking of him or her and think into the future and about consequences for most of these to work.

This is the best for younger kids. I recommend reading the first couple chapters at least two or three times and have both parents locked in on the philosophy. It takes a strong resolve to practice love and logic parenting. But it is the most healthy and loving thing you can do for the whole family.

Really great book with great advice. So glad I read it early (14 months) to start practicing. Makes total sense allowing kids choices with boundaries.

This is a GREAT book for families. Would recommend for anyone looking for basic principles to last a lifetime. I've recommended this to countless people. It gives you the language and many examples. Love and Logic books are plentiful, so they can be repetitive since the core ideas are the same, but someone looking at a place to start, this works.
