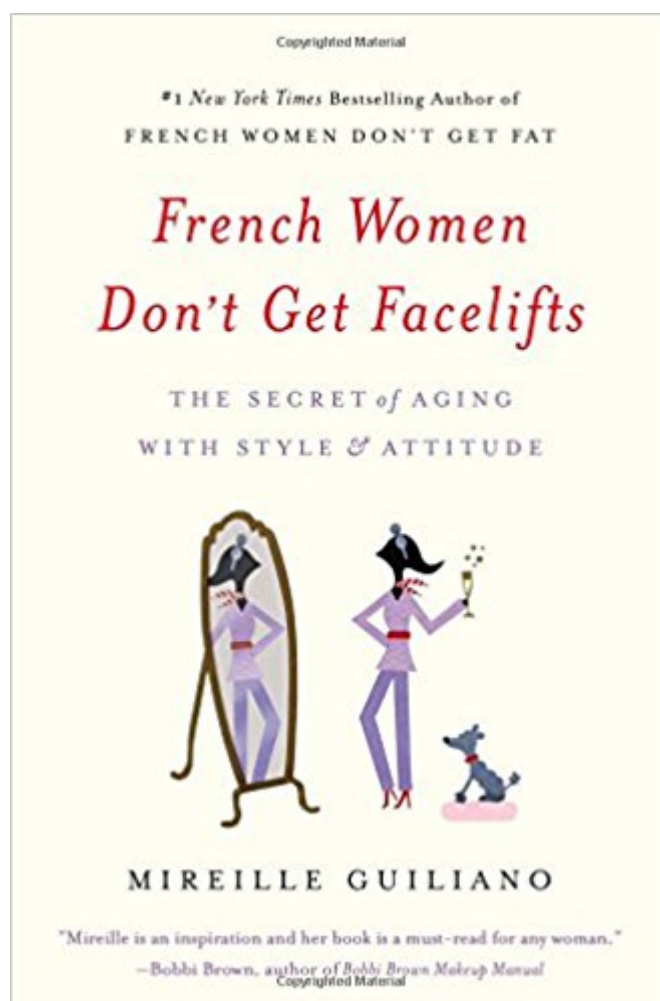

It doesn't flow well, and the thoughts are poorly organized, as if they had been jotted down on airplane cocktail napkins and typed up by an assistant. And the content itself is, well, so basic and trite as to be pretty much worthless. What happened? Not sure, but I really regret having spent money on this book. There's nothing here but Ms. Guiliano's brand, and she isn't doing it any favors. She really should have worked harder for her readers.

I found the book quite boring and full of old fashioned hints. I am not at all interested in plastic surgery so my view is not based on disagreement with her thesis, just that there really is nothing new to offer. I'm not sure that French women really have it all over everyone else unless conservative style is your bag.
