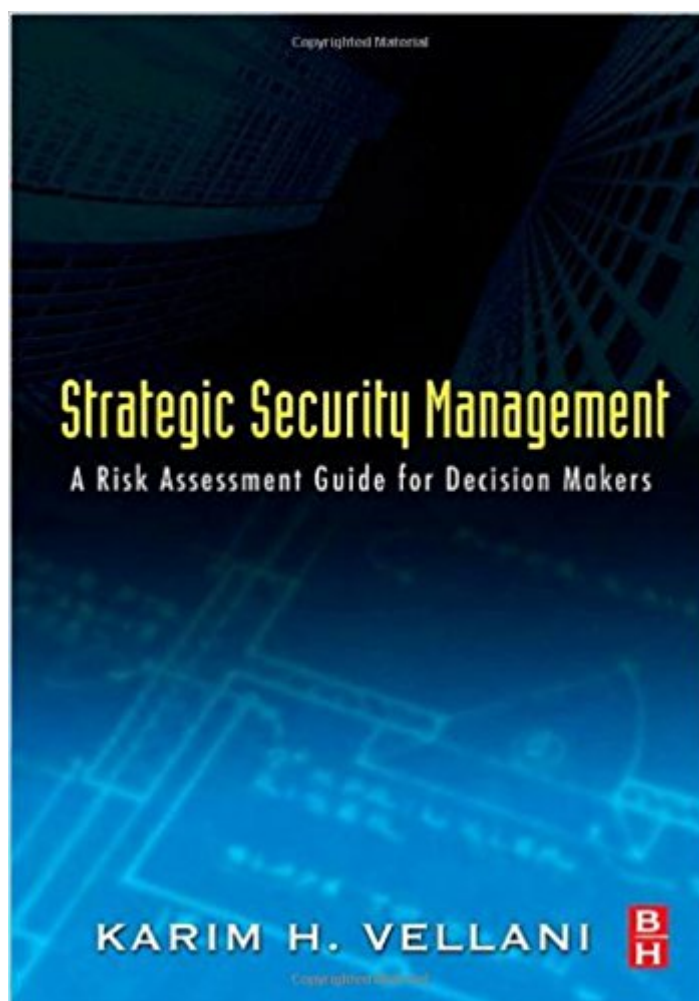

Some duplication with other related reference material but some very good case examples on the practical limitations, commercial relevance and planning challenges of industrial security at a strategic level. At times there is an over emphasis on developed country resources and planning considerations such as CPTED but expanded in parts to make the argument for a global solution outside of police reports and RSO advice; which most acknowledge as of limited affect outside of the US/UK. I found the crime analysis section to be very informative and practical.
