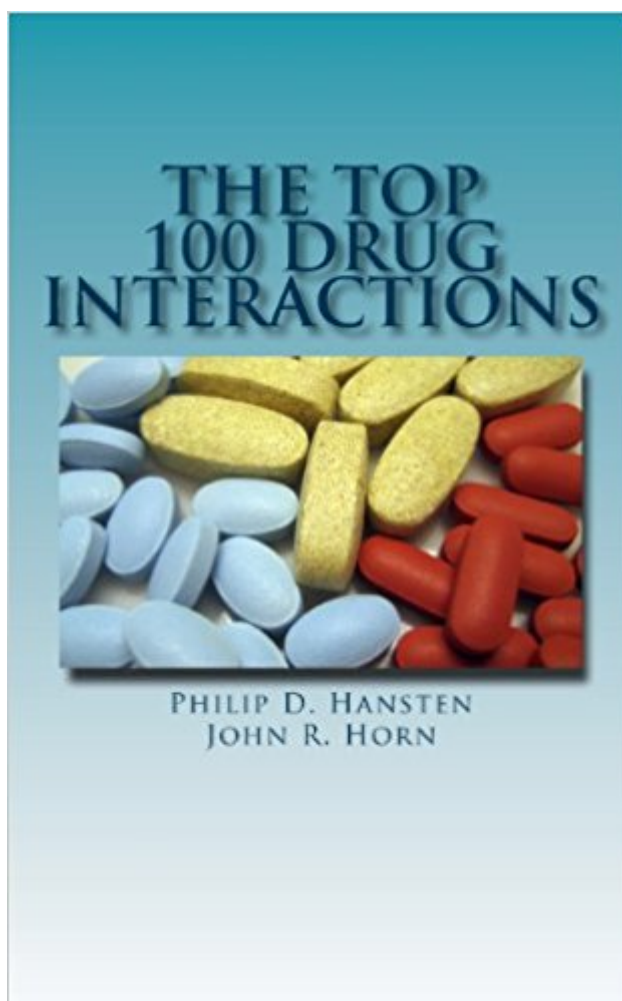

The book also contains a clinically useful and comprehensive table of drugs that are substrates, inhibitors or inducers of cytochrome P450 isozymes and ABC transporters.

Their drug interaction books have been translated into 6 languages and have sold more than one million copies worldwide since 1971. Hansten and Horn have lectured extensively in North America and in over two-dozen countries worldwide.

I call this sweet book my drug interaction bible. I take it everywhere I work. I also suggest it to all students that I encounter along the way. It is important to note that the drug CYP450 table is compiled by human trials ONLY. NO in-vitro or animal studies. The classifications of the interactions gives you practical information and insight on how concerned you should be. I am also VERY
