

Czechmate, by Felicia Bridges, weaves traditional Czech folklore with modern day action-adventure. It also keeps the reader holding her breath through long stretches. Bridges' protagonist, Nicole Wise, is a beautifully flawed-but-sincere character. Nicole is strong in her faith and bold in her witness, but she is also headstrong and wrestles with pride. What starts with teen angst at leaving her friends behind in Raleigh, NC, to spend a year on mission in the Czech Republic, ends for Nicole as a perilous escape and rescue adventure when political unrest erupts. Only through prayer

and firm faith in God's sovereignty--no matter what the outcome--is Nicole able to face fear and walk through danger. Czechmate is the first title in Bridges' International Mission Force series, which I am hoping will visit more of the international missionary kids that Nicole joins in an online group. The narrative in Volume 1 hints of adventure in the lives of other IMF teens, which I am confident will yield stories as compelling as Nicole's. As an English teacher by profession, I would highly recommend Czechmate for preteens and teens. While there are moments of violence due to the nature of the narrative, nothing is graphic or gratuitous. The Nicole-Jakob relationship is sweet and appropriate for older children and teens. Adults will enjoy the adventure too. It's a quick day-at-the-beach or poolside read. Young Adult fiction as a genre is ablaze in the secular world, but there has been a dearth of quality Christian-themed titles, especially action-adventure or mystery titles. Bridges' series shows promise in supplying young readers with quality fiction in line with Christian values.

This is a very well written book. It is easy to read, easy to follow and easy to get caught up into from the beginning. I have to say if I had the time I could have easily read it all in one sitting. It ended up taking me longer and near the end I was conflicted in finishing it as fast as possible or dragging it out longer because I really didn't want it to end. Felicia writes in exquisite detail and the conflict rolls seamlessly throughout the novel keeping the reader engaged. I am very excited to dive into the next book in the series. This is a must read for young women who are looking to be leaders in their communities
