

I bought this book to supplement my text book with extra NCLEX style questions. At first I loved this book because it pretty much gave me a summary of all the important things regarding psych disorders. I would have given it 5 stars on this alone but the reason I bought it was because it said it gave me access to over 700 NCLEX style questions. Well each chapter has 10 pretest question and 10 post test questions. I then realized that I had an access code and that the rest of the NCLEX questions would be online... Not the case! Using my access code gave me access to absolutely NOTHING online because you have to be enrolled in a class in order to access the questions. I just wanted this to self study for NCLEX and I even reached out to Pearsons via live chat to ask were I could access these "700 NCLEX style questions" and all they told me was that they did not allow a "self study course" I wish I had known that before or else I would have bought a different book or at least not used the access code and returned it. Now I'm only stuck with 20 questions per chapter which is very disappointing.

Unfortunately the book had most of the answers in it already written in pen so I couldn't even go through the book and erase what others have filled in.
