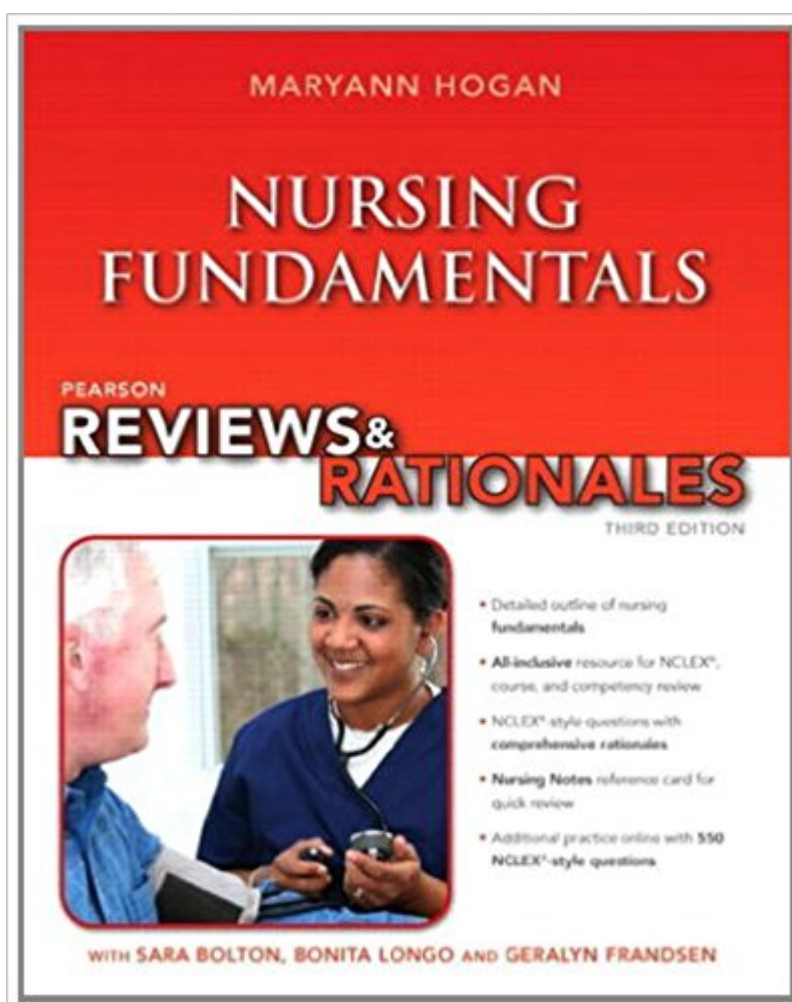

I have an account on Pearson Website, the site for this book and the others, but the "code" on the inside is a useless bunch of letters because it gets you no access to anything! NOTHING.
