

Synopsis

Have you ever seen a tourist at a subway station who is asking 23 times of the direction for his/her destination? Are you sure to find your hotel with the limited information of A¢â ¬Å"10 minutes from the exit M6 of MRT Taipei Main Stationâ⠬•? Which way will you take when you come out of the exit M2 of the bustling metro station? This book introduces 20 attractions of Taiwan including 18 must-visits in Taipei (啠åÅ'â"), the capital city of Taiwan. Alishan National Scenic Area (阿éâ ¡Å'å Â Ã¥Å"â å®Â¶Ã©Â¢Â"镡å•â ¬) and Sun Moon Lake $(\tilde{A}|\hat{a} \ \tilde{A} + \tilde{A}|\hat{A} \ \tilde{B} + \tilde{A}|\hat{A} \ \hat{A} -)$, the 2 giant attractions in the central district of Taiwan, will follow them. As a backpacker to the world, I especially emphasize the way to the attractions of Taiwan in this book. In addition to the detailed information on the ways to the must-visits, you will find maps and photos taken every nook and corner. For example, this book introduces Shifen (啕¥ˆâ), one of the best attractions in Taiwan, through a map as below. ââ ¬Å"Take a train to Ruifang (çâ Â Â Â Â) at Taipei Railway Station as indicated by the first red arrow on the map, and transfer to Pingxi Line (å Â Ã|ºÂªÃ§Â Å¡) bound for Shifen (啕åˆâ). The second red arrow shows the way between Ruifang and Shifen (啕åˆâ). There are 3 kinds of train at Taipei Main Station. However, for Ruifang where you have to transfer train to Pingxi Line, you $don\tilde{A}\phi\hat{a} - \hat{a},\phi$ t need to take an express line or even a normal one. Commuter train, the cheapest one, might be enough. For the commuter train bound for Ruifang, go down to the basement of Taipei Railway Station, and wait for the train at platform No. 4B.â⠬•In addition to the arrows and explaining boxes on the map, photos taken on the way from the starting point until the destination will give you full confidence when you try the wonderful attractions by yourself. Download this book in your cell phone and fly to the fantastic city of Taipei. Then, your mobile phone will shed light on your way to the must-visits. You need neither to chase after a guide nor to ask passers-by for your destination. You can get them all by your own self.
