

Just got this book and it is part of the new series so thought a review would add. The book says 5+ but it is mostly an early chapter book but one with a lot of pictures. There is never more than 2 paragraphs on one page but the sentences are longer and would be better for reading with a adult at a 4 year old level or a reader that is pretty good with Step 3 type books and need something similar. There are 6 Chapters with about 12 pages of writing (additional pages with just pictures along with pictures below the text on the other pages) and in this book there are several poems/songs that the girls sing while getting ready for their show 'Fall for Fall'. Along with a page of "Meet the Welliewishers" with short bios and a "garden map" at the end of the book there is a "For Parents" section about crafts about "Managing Strong Emotions" with ideas in categories "Creative Engagement" and "Boredom Busters"

Like the other books in this series the illustrations are amazingly well done. The dolls are beautifully illustrated. This one is extra charming because the fall season is so well done and the girls are also adorably dressing up. This book is mostly about the girls resolving their disagreements and learning to cooperate. It's not as lighthearted as Willa's Robin story and very similar to Ashlyn's book. I wish this book and Ashlyn's book were less serious given the age range of these dolls. For some reason AG seems to make the books for younger girls too serious in my opinion. They did the same thing with the Bitty Baby books. I'm sure like her Bitty Baby books my daughter will enjoy this book when she gets to open it on her birthday because the illustrations are so well done. Plus for once AG has priced these books very reasonably so I don't regret the purchase even if I do wish they were more fun.

I got this for my 5 year old daughter who got the wellie wisher, Emerson for Christmas. She loved the book. It's a cute book about good friends. It's a good introduction into chapter books for kindergarteners. The chapters are short and there are lots of pictures.

I've been a huge American Girls fan my whole life, and now that I have a daughter I've been waiting for her to be old enough to read the books. I was so excited when the Wellie Wishers series came out because it's the perfect level for her (age 4). We read this one aloud in about 30 minutes. It focuses on friendship lessons and is very sweet. The illustrations are also beautiful.

My six year old loves all the books we've gotten so far! The illustrations are beautiful and the writing is manageable for her but still enjoyable for my 9 year old niece. Great job! We're eagerly awaiting more!

She found all the WellieWisher dolls in the book and naming them. She was excited to find her doll. The book is for a more advanced reader, she is four. But after being the read the book by her older siblings and grandmother, she was able to 'read' the story to us. I plan to buy more of the books for her upcoming birthday.

I read this chapter book to my 6 year old daughter and she likes the story lines in these Welliwisher series.
