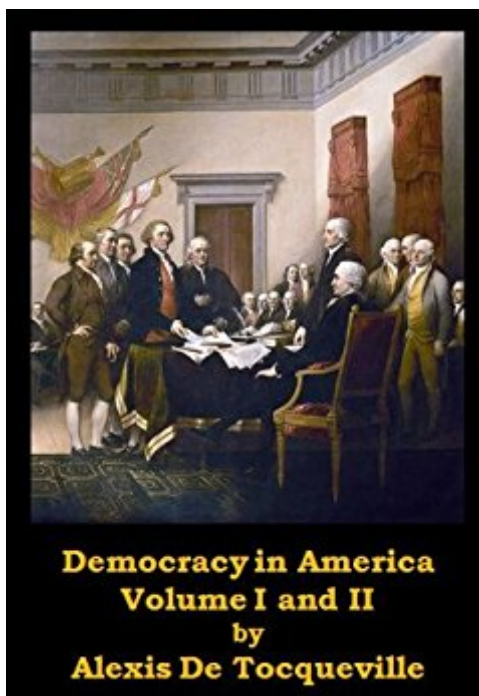

His work is larger considering the environment of limited news media and communications of his times (1830's).
