

This book is awesome, and very self-explanatory about the importance of conserving water, and the fact that the Earth is made of 70% water and that we shouldn't drink salty ocean water. And that people should take showers instead of baths and people should only flush when it's necessary to do so, and that modern plumbing uses less water than older ones. However, this book could have mentioned about how to conserve water when doing laundry and when doing the dishes: for instance modern washing machines conserve as much water as hand-washing the clothes compared to classic-style ones that allow people to fill the tub based on load size, and that hand-washing the dishes and other kitchenwares is easier on the water bills than letting them get cleaned alone in the dishwasher. Household appliances play a large role in water usage as much as other equipment that use water. Overall, this makes a great book to read and learn from, but could have been better with mentioning more stuff that use water and how important it is to conserve water with those too.

Just as a warning, there is a page in the book that I did not find 100% appropriate for 5-6 year olds. The page talks about not flushing the toilet after #1 to save water and says "If it is pee, let it be"Well, I am not sure that I agree with the tip, and I don't think I like the use of the word "pee" in the book. Specially since I will be reading these books at local schools as part of a volunteer program. Other than that, the book is fine.
